# CD lining up snowmobiles

## New emergency service planned

The Onondaga County Office of Civil Defense is forming a new emergency service — snowmobiles. Civil Defense officials plan setting up snowmobile emergency rescue units in all 19 towns in Onondaga County.

Robert S. Burbank, head of the CD rescue service has issued an invitation to all snowmobile owners in the county to join the operation.

Snowmobiles, under the operation, would be used to deliver food, fuel, medical supplies, transportation to and from isolated areas, search for lost persons and check stranded vehicles during blizzard snow conditions, said Burbank.

Burbank said only licensed owners of the tracked snow vehicles will be eligible to join.

He said a training program for the unit will be developed, including a 16-hour course in first aid.

Interested persons are asked to contact CD Assistant Director Willard Smith at CD headquarters, 735 Glenwood Ave.

## 9 deaths in January accidental

The greatest number of accidental deaths in Onondaga County last month occurred in the home, with fire accounting for the death of two children and falls resulting in death for three elderly persons.

This information was contained in a report issued by the Greater Syracuse Safety Council stating that nine persons died accidentally in the county in January.

Pedestrians accounted for two motor vehicle deaths, with both victims being over age 70.

In the public non-motor vehicle accidental death category one person died in an accidental fall in a public building and another died as the probably result of asphyxiation while sleeping in a car with the motor running.

## Liquor stolen; 2 youths seized

Two youths pleaded innocent in City Court yesterday to charges of possession of stolen goods.

The pair, Tyrone Cooper, 28, of 119 E. Beard St., and James Jones, 17, of 223 Lincoln Ave., were released on \$550 bail each by Judge Morris Garber.

They were arrested last night after police found eight bottles of bourbon in their possession. Officers said the liquor had been stolen from the Arrow Liquor Store, 216 W. Onondaga St., early this morning.

The pair will reappear March 9.

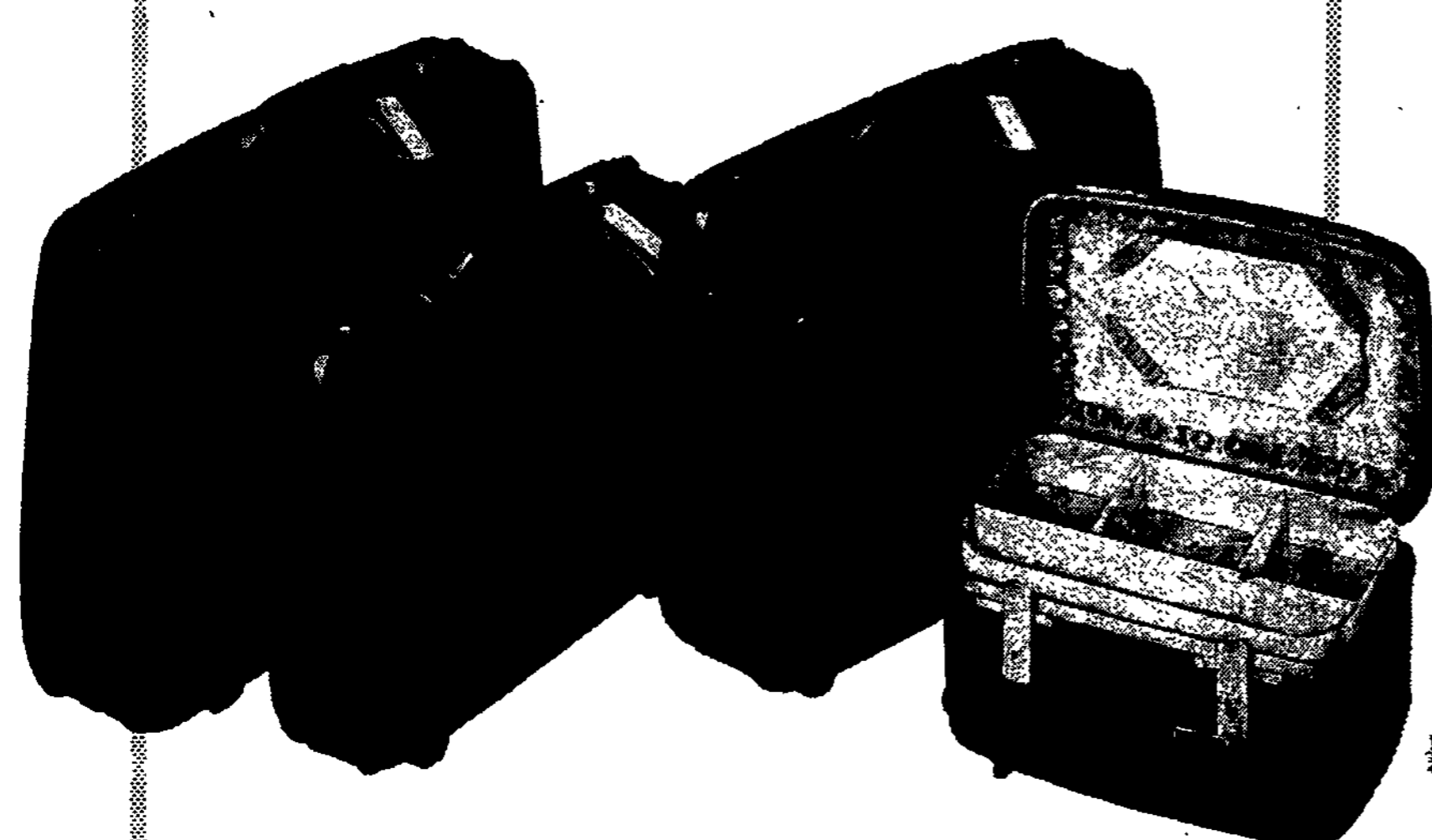
